Our response

Please find attached an extract of our internal database for both requests, internal review and complains. This covers the period from 1 January 2021 to 31 May 2026. We have left in comments where adjustments were made to the deadline as set out in the Freedom of Information Act (eg restarting the clock following clarification of a request).

We publish statistics annually based on this database in the [Open government reports | GOV.WALES](#). The data we have provided may give slightly different figures to those published due to updates to older requests, corrections and how we calculate those statistics (for example, we do not include withdrawn requests).
