ATISN 27233 - Mynydd Maen Wind Farm, Trecelyn Wind Farm, Rhyswg Wind Farm, and the Mynydd Llanhilleth Wind Farm

Thank you for your request submitted on 19 July, which I received on the 27 July.

Your request asks for:

Under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004, I request all recorded information — including emails, letters, meeting notes, minutes, and diary or calendar entries — evidencing communications between the Welsh Government (including Welsh Ministers, special advisers, and officials) and any of the following, **or their agents, consultants, land agents, solicitors or other representatives**, from **1 January 2024** to the date of this request:

- RES (Renewable Energy Systems Ltd), concerning the Mynydd Maen Wind Farm (DNS/3276725);
- Pennant Walters Ltd, concerning the Trecelyn Wind Farm (DNS CAS-02114-J9X4S6), the Rhyswg Wind Farm, and the Mynydd Llanhilleth Wind Farm (DNS CAS-03540-M8J8M5).

For the avoidance of doubt, this includes any communications concerning site visits or tours offered to, or attended by, Members of the Senedd or Welsh Government officials.

If any information is withheld under an EIR exception, please identify the specific exception, give your public-interest reasoning, and disclose the remainder. If clarification would help bring this within the appropriate limit under the Regulations, please contact me before refusing on cost grounds. I am content to receive the information electronically.

As the information sought would take more than 24 hours to tabulate, process, consider potential exemptions and then redact the information, prior to release due to the number of Welsh Government Departments, Including Energy, Planning, Economic Development amongst others. In my view the request as it stands would

be considered manifestly unreasonable. The Welsh Government does not hold information on activities of Senedd Members. You would need to write to each Senedd Member for such information.

If you can refine your request further by concentrating on specific departments e.g. planning or what specific information it is you want access to, what are the question(s) you want answers to, what is it you want to understand and focus your request onto that specific information, rather than asking for everything in the hope it might contain what you are looking for. If you do refine your request in this way, this will be treated as a new request.

The request you sent me contains personal information about you - for example, your name and e-mail address. The Welsh Government will be the data processor for this information and, in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation, it will be processed in order to fulfil our public task and meet our legal obligations under the Act to provide you with a response. We will only use this personal information to deal with your request and any matters which arise as a result of it. We will keep your personal information and all other information relating to your request for three years from the date on which your request is finally closed. Your personal information will then be disposed of securely.

Under data protection legislation, you have the right:

- to be informed of the personal data we hold about you and to access it
- to require us to rectify inaccuracies in that data
- to (in certain circumstances) object to or restrict processing
- for (in certain circumstances) your data to be 'erased'
- to (in certain circumstances) data portability
- to lodge a complaint with the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) who is our independent regulator for data protection
