Request for Information - ATISN 27245

Further to your request for information. I sent you a clarification letter on 23 July but unfortunately, as I have not received any further clarification, I will not be able to process your request on this occasion. You may, of course, make a new FOI request, should you wish to do so.

I am however providing you a link to police accident which is already in the public domain on our Welsh Government website.

Once on the page with the map you can use the filters at the top of the page to change which collisions you're being shown. Using the "year" filter you can click any year to only show that year's values. If you click off the currently selected year, you should be able to see every collision in the area you're looking for from 2018 to Q1 2026. Using the "quarter" filter, it is currently default set to quarter 4. If you untick Q4, all quarters throughout that year should appear on the map. If selecting all collisions for all available years, then this may take a little while to load.

If you want to see the severity of the collision, you can select using the "severity" filter whether you would like to see fatal, serious, or slight collisions depending on what you select. However, the map is also colour coded, so red dots are fatal collisions, orange dots are serious collisions, and blue are slight.

Next steps

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government's handling of your request, you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response.
