Thank you for your request which I received on 24 July 2026. You asked for:

Please provide details of all contracts awarded by the Welsh Government, including its departments, executive agencies, and sponsored bodies where the information is held by the Welsh Government, for:

- Insurance services
- Employee benefits services
- Health & safety training services
- Health & safety consultancy services

for the period 1 January 2020 to the present date.

For each contract, please provide, where available:

- Contract title
- Brief description of the services provided
- Supplier name
- Contract value
- Award date
- Contract start and end dates (or contract duration)
- Department, agency, or body awarding the contract
- Procurement method used (e.g. open tender, framework agreement, direct award or call-off)

If any of the requested information is already publicly available, please provide links to the relevant sources.

I would prefer to receive the information electronically by email in Excel or CSV format where possible.

Our response

Welsh Government only record contracts above £25,000, requirements below this value are recorded as individual purchase order transactions. Some of the information that you have requested is available in the public domain. The Welsh Government Contracts Register includes all contracts above £25,000 on [Sell2Wales](#) where a contract award notice has been published. This is accessible via this link: [Contracts search - Sell2Wales](#), where you can filter by a range of different codes.

The results can be exported to excel and this provides the information requested, including project title, who the contract was awarded to, the value of the contract,

whether it is a framework and the date of award. Each record in the report can be individually selected to obtain the contract award notice, the full notice text will provide the full information including the procurement method used.

The Welsh Government does not hold other organisations contract information including executive agencies and sponsored bodies, you would need to contact those organisations separately. However, some other contracting authorities also enable the sell2wales contracts register, the full sell2wales contracts register report can be found here [Contracts search - Sell2Wales](#).

This wider register can be searched by 'Buyer' name on the right-hand side. By searching 'Commercial Delivery' in the buyer selection, this will show the collaborative contracts and frameworks that the Welsh Government have awarded that are available for use by the wider Welsh public Sector. Searching Welsh Government under the 'Buyer' will update the report with recent award notices.

Next steps
