Thank you for your request which I received on 28 July 2026. You asked for:

Please provide a copy of your organisation's current contracts register, or a list of all contracts currently held. For each contract, please include the following fields where available:

- Supplier or contractor name
- Contract title or description
- Contract value (estimated or actual)
- Contract start date
- Contract end date (including any extension dates)
- Department or service area responsible
- Procurement method or tender route
- Contract reference number

I would be grateful if this could be provided in a machine-readable format (CSV or Excel) where possible.

If a contracts register is already published online, please direct me to the relevant URL.

Our response

Welsh Government only record contracts above £25,000; requirements below this value are recorded as individual purchase order transactions. The information that you have requested is available in the public domain. The Welsh Government Contracts Register includes all contracts above £25,000 on Sell2Wales where a contract award notice has been published. This is accessible via this link: [Contracts search - Sell2Wales](#), where you can search by a 'Welsh Government' as the Buyer name on the right hand-side and filter by a range of different codes. By searching 'Commercial Delivery' in the buyer selection, this will show the collaborative contracts and frameworks that the Welsh Government have awarded that are available for use by the wider Welsh public Sector.

The results can be exported to excel and provides the majority of the information requested, including contract title, who the contract was awarded to, the value of the contract, the contract number, whether it is a framework and the date of award and end date. Each record in the report can be individually selected to obtain the contract award notice, the full notice text will provide the full information including the procurement method used.

The department or business area is not identified as these can change during the contract period.
