Thank you for your request submitted on 9 July, which was received by the Welsh Government on the same day.

Your request asks for:

- “Please find attached my Environmental Information Regulations (EIR) request concerning public-health warnings and environmental-risk communications relating to the Maen Hir and Alaw Môn solar developments in Anglesey.”

Our response

The information caught by your request constitutes environmental information and has been considered for disclosure under the Environmental Information Regulations (“EIRs”). I have decided some of the information described is exempt from disclosure under Regulation 14(2) of the EIRs as it appears to be a duplicate of your previous request, reference ATISN 26744 which is published at: <https://www.gov.wales/atisn26744>. Therefore, this repeat request is refused.

Next steps

However, please note that the Commissioner will not normally investigate a complaint until it has been through our own internal review process.
