I am writing to inform you the Planning Directorate of the Welsh Government received a copy of the Inspector's Report and associated documentation on your application, outlined above, from Planning and Environment Decisions Wales (PEDW), on 12 March.

However, the Welsh Ministers have powers under s.62L(5) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 to suspend the determination period.
