Regarding the DSRC event, officials continue to work with Business in Focus on the format of the event. Given the likely attendance of senior UK Government Ministers, officials would advise accepting the invitation to attend the event and deliver a key-note speech on Thursday 3 September. Alternatively, there is an option for the First Minister to attend the awards dinner on Thursday evening to deliver a speech if diary does not allow attendance during the day. If the First Minister is unable to deliver the key-note speech on Thursday, organisers have asked whether the Cabinet Minister

for Enterprise Connectivity & Energy would be able to deliver a key-note speech in First Minister's place.
