Minister is asked to note: As a co-sponsor of DSRC, I extend an invitation for you to speak and join our panel discussion at the keynote and to meet exhibitors and sponsors on 3 Sep 2026. We will work with your officials on the details.

We have had a similar letter for the FM and the advice was below:

Advice

Given that Business in Focus have also written to [REDACTED] with a similar request aligned more closely with portfolio responsibilities, officials recommend declining a meeting between the Prif Weinidog and Business in Focus, as engagement is more appropriately undertaken by the [REDACTED].

Regarding the DSRC event, officials continue to work with [REDACTED] on the format of the event. Given the likely attendance of senior UK Government Ministers, officials would advise accepting the invitation to attend the event and deliver a key-note speech on Thursday 3 September. Alternatively, there is an option for the First Minister to attend the awards dinner on Thursday evening to deliver a speech if diary does not allow attendance during the day.

If the First Minister is unable to deliver the key-note speech on Thursday, organisers have asked whether [REDACTED] would be able to deliver a key-note speech in First Minister's place.
