Near the top end of this short street; opposite the Baptist Chapel churchyard and detached to left. Known as Baptist Square.

Early C19 2-storey local rubble structure with slate roof and rubble chimney stacks (one heightened in brick) with weathercoursing; formerly two cottages. 9 and 12-pane sash windows and horned sash window inserted to right in former doorway; half glazed door. Paved forecourt with rubble wall and gate. Cement render left end and flat roof extension at rear.

Set in the slope below the former Baptist Chapel. Known as Baptist Square.

Mid C19. 2-storey rubble terrace of 1-window fronts with slate roof and stock brick chimney stacks. Various types of glazing; horned and small pane sashes, small pane casements and modern windows. No 7 has 4-panel door, otherwise half glazed and modern doors. Modern extensions to rear.

Included for group value with No 5 and the former Baptist Chapel.
