I've had a homeowner contact me lately asking for a site meeting to discuss a property. [REDACTED]
[REDACTED] [They have] also mentioned trying to get it de-listed.

I've outlined this process and advised [REDACTED] [them] to get in touch directly with Cadw, but [REDACTED]
[REDACTED] [they have] asked questions on the listing and its group value with the nearby Chapel,
which was subsequently de-listed in 2019 (details attached). [REDACTED]

The building in question is 6 Llawr Gors (or Baptist Square) Pwllheli – ref 4536. Its listed
along with the rest of the terrace and all descriptions are very vague but makes reference to
the group value with the chapel. Do you have any further information on these at all within
the original file? There are 6 altogether and the descriptions are the same for all of them.
The owner has brought up the question of whether they should still be listed as the main
reason for listing according to the description is for the group value with the chapel, but as
this was de-listed in 2019 – should they be looked at again?

Either way I've told the owner to contact yourselves if [REDACTED] [they] intend to pursue de-
listing as the terrace is still listed as things stand. [REDACTED] [!]
wondered whether there were any further details or background in the file.
