Thank you for your request which I received on 26/08/2026 and 04/09/2026. The information requested in both FOI's are of very similar nature and I will be combining the response to both requests.

Following a search of our paper and electronic records, find below our findings on the information you asked for:

Question 1: Any record, from 2016 to the present, of Jason Arday giving evidence to, advising, being consulted by, being contracted by, or attending meetings with the Welsh Government, its ministers, its officials, or any advisory group, task and finish group, steering group, expert panel or external reference group convened by it, concerning anti-racism strategy, race equality or related matters, including the development, drafting, implementation or review of the Anti-racist Wales Action Plan.

We hold some information

- Professor Arday's previous External Accountability Group appointment ended on 31 March 2026, and he did not submit an Expression of Interest to continue as a member of the EAG.
- These are the dates of the External Accountability Group (EAG) and related meetings Professor Arday attended.
- He never claimed any expense for attending the meetings below.
