


# SOCIAL DISTANCING

## **Food parcel orders submitted to suppliers:**

- **9,365** up to 4 May
- Includes **400** received over the weekend

## **Attempted deliveries:**

- **16,279** up to 30 April (8,255 were redeliveries)
- **98%** handed to resident or left on doorstep

# DISCRETIONARY ASSISTANCE FUND (DAF)

Between 18 March and 30 April:

**9,540** COVID-19 related  
Emergency Assistance  
Payments, with a total paid  
value of **£590,520**

Recording started on 18 March. COVID-19 related reasons applicants are presenting include


- Having to stop or reduce work
- Delay to benefit claim
- Increased energy/food costs (family at home)

To date, the increase in claims is partly due to more frequent applications by people who have previously claimed EAPs.

# SUPPORT FOR BUSINESSES


Local authorities have so far issued **44,300** business rates grants totalling almost **£550m**.

The Development Bank's COVID-19 Wales Business Loan Scheme received **1,608** applications totalling **£103m**. **1,142** businesses across Wales have been awarded funding totalling **£69m**.

The Economic Resilience Fund has received almost **6,900** micro-business applications totalling **£66.9m**, and almost **2,600** SME applications totalling **£142.8m**. The Larger Business Fund has received over **£26m** worth of applications, with further applications being processed which show the applications will likely increase to about **£28m**.


Number and amount of business rates grants awarded
