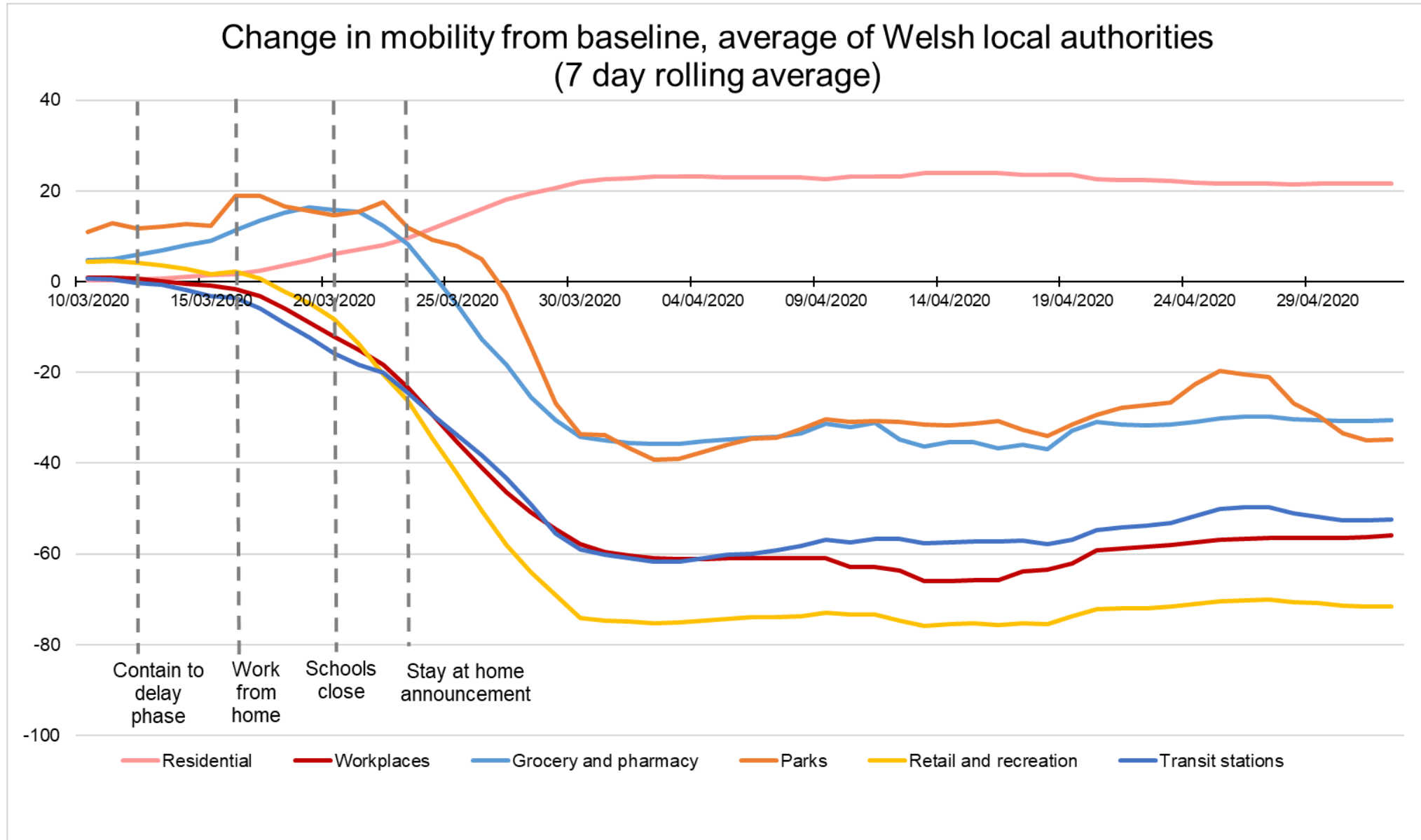


SOCIAL DISTANCING

Food parcel orders submitted to suppliers:

- **10,693** up to 11 May
- Includes **353** submitted over the bank holiday weekend

Attempted deliveries:

- **25,419** up to 7 May
- **98%** handed to resident or left on doorstep
- **9,705** of which were successful first deliveries

DISCRETIONARY ASSISTANCE FUND (DAF)

Between 18 March and 6 May:

10,857 COVID-19 related
Emergency Assistance
Payments, with a total paid
value of **£671,560**

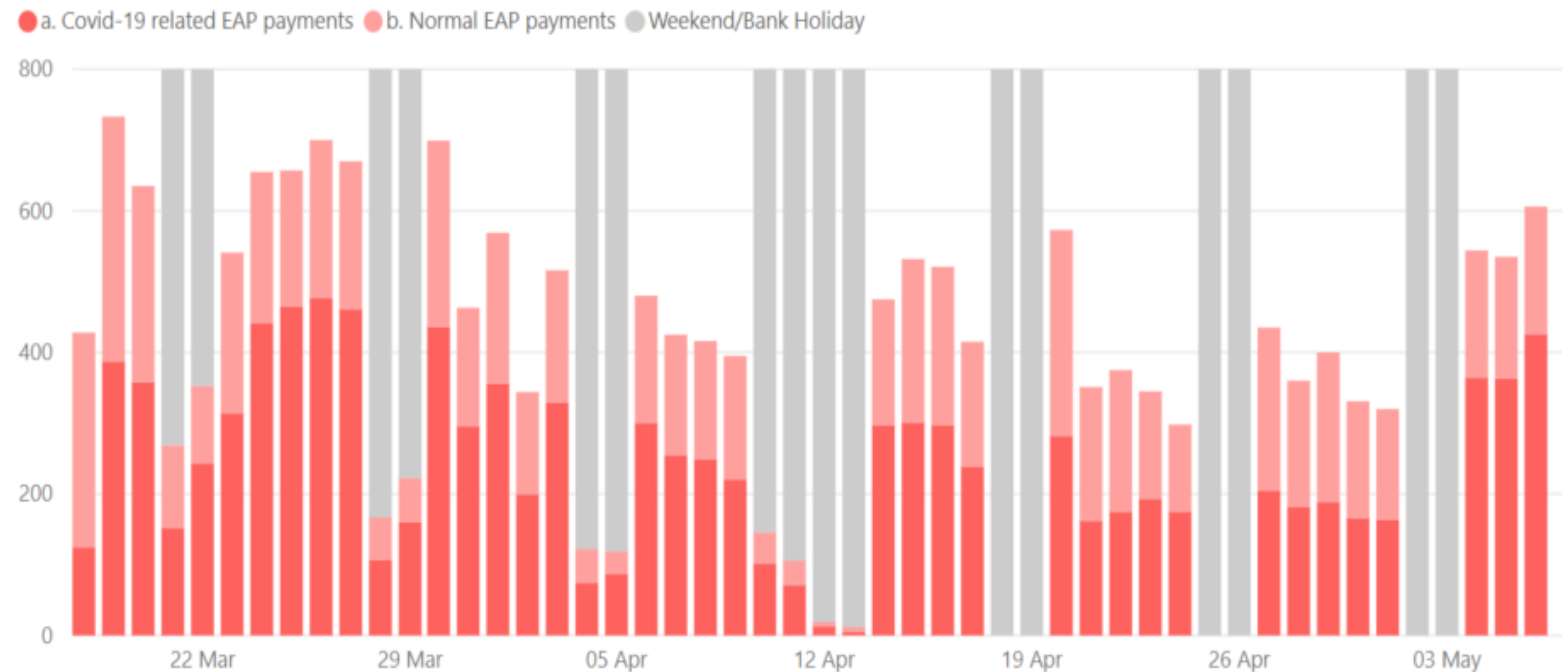
Recording started on 18 March. COVID-19 related reasons applicants are presenting include

- Having to stop or reduce work
- Delay to benefit claim
- Increased energy/food costs (family at home)

Following the 1 May announcement of increased funding, applications will be treated with greater discretion and flexibility, when dealing with COVID-19 hardship claims.

SUPPORT FOR BUSINESSES

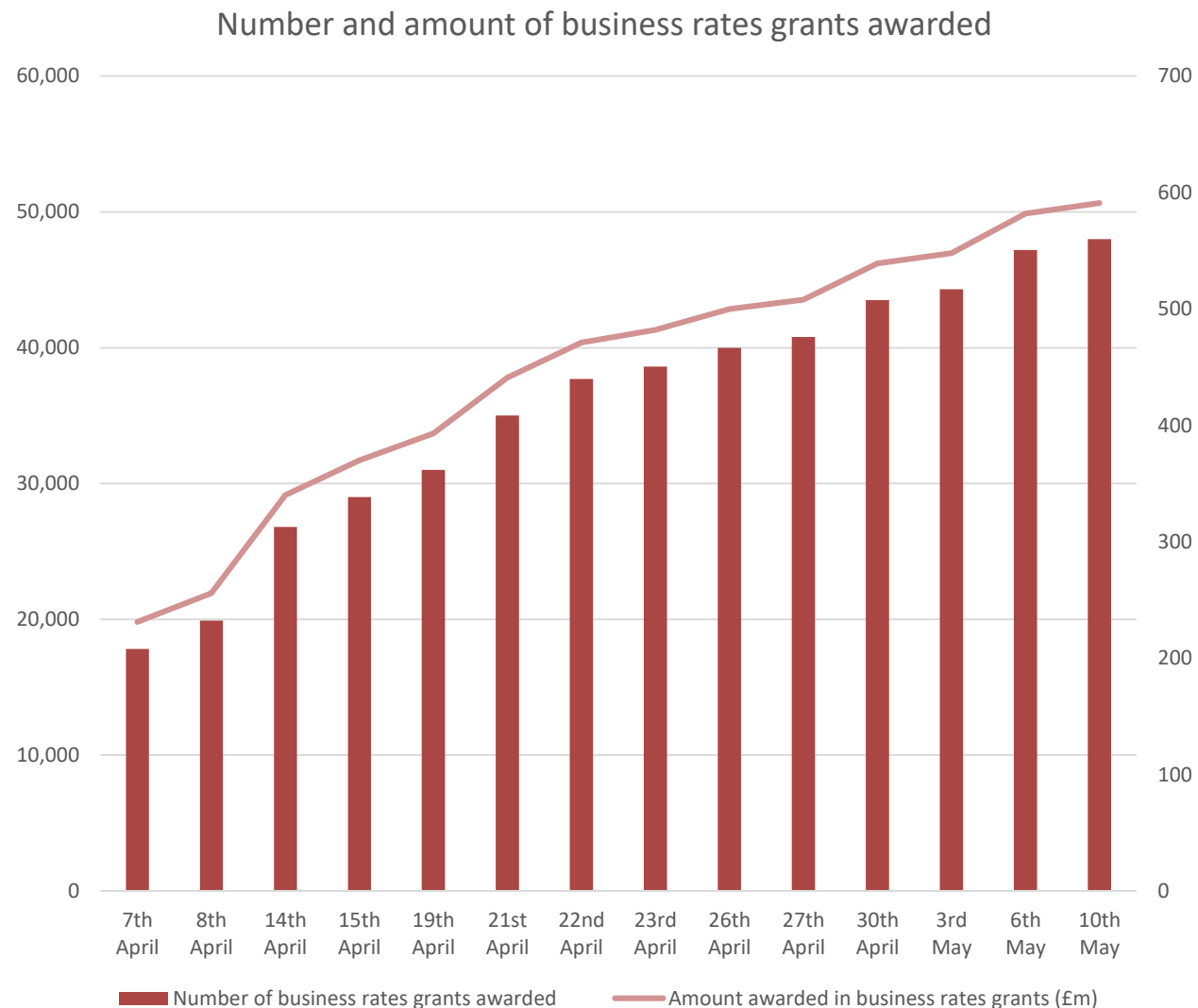
Local authorities have so far issued **48,000** business rates grants totalling **£591m**.

The Development Bank's COVID-19 Wales Business Loan Scheme received **1,608** applications totalling **£103m**. **1,303** businesses across Wales have been awarded funding totalling **£82m**.

The Economic Resilience Fund has received almost **6,900** micro-business applications totalling **£66.9m**, and almost **2,600** SME applications totalling **£142.8m**. The Larger Business Fund has received over **£26m** worth of applications, with further applications being processed which show the applications will likely increase to about **£28m**.

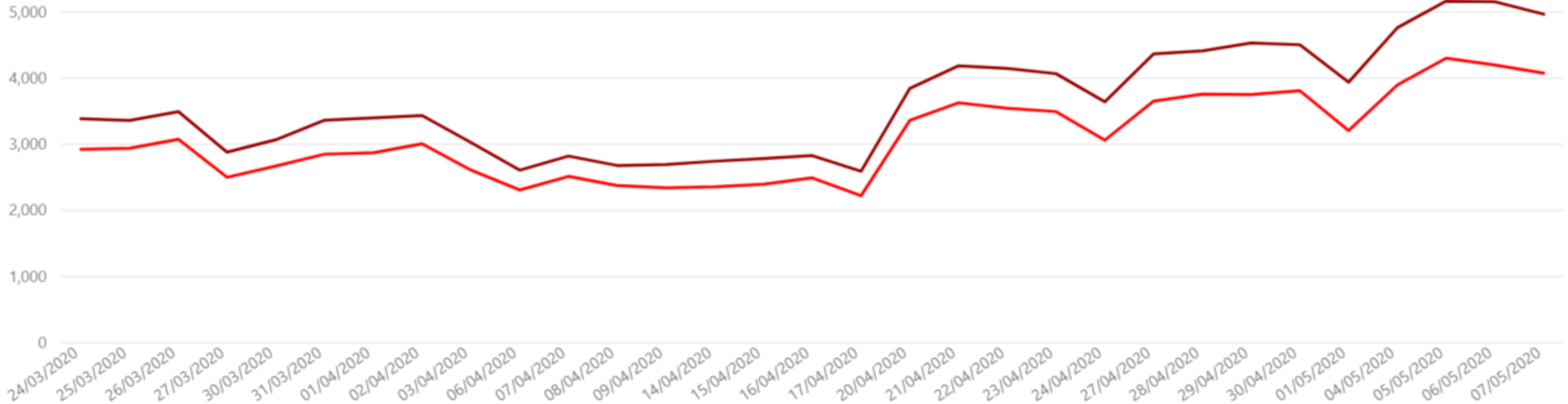
