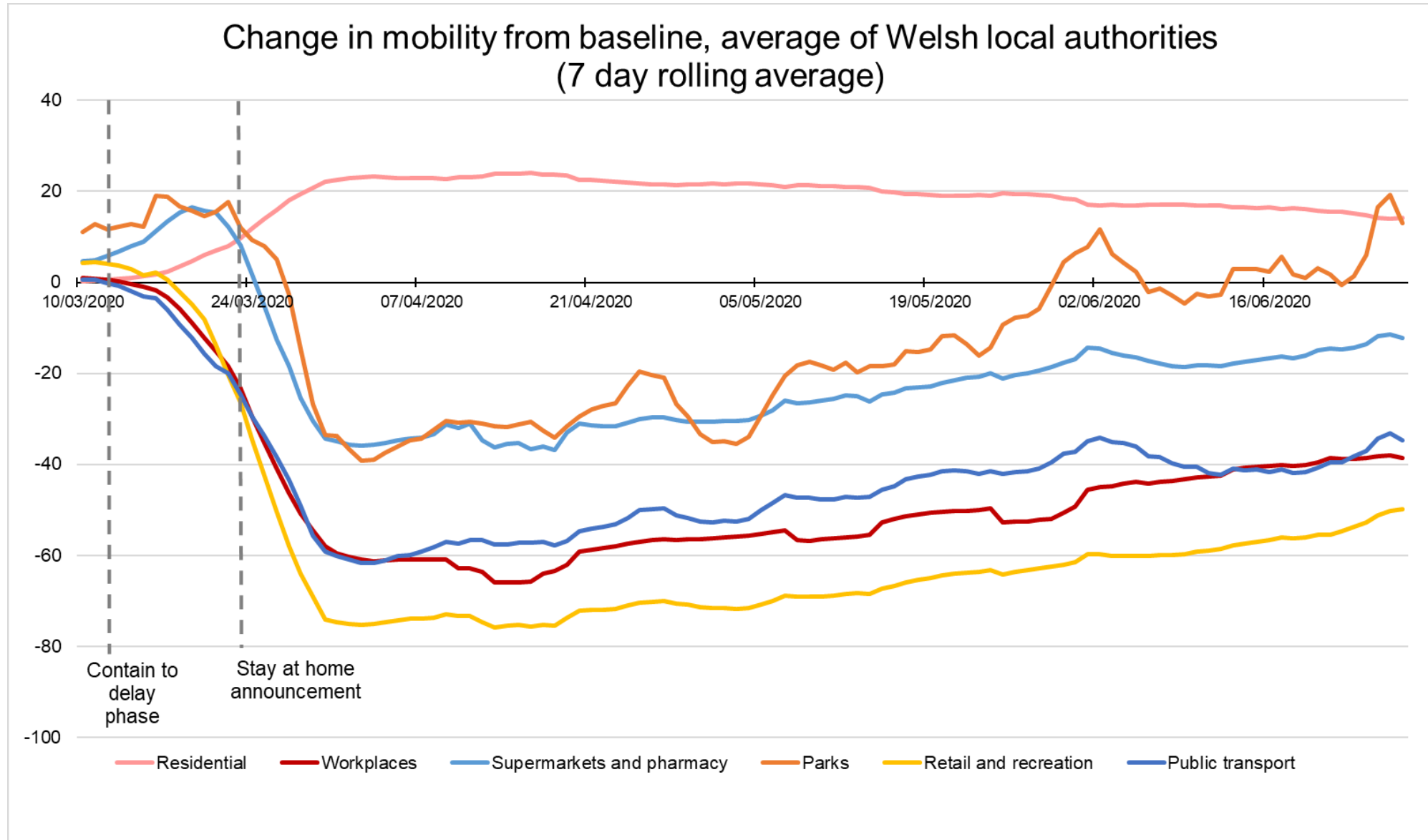

# FOOD PARCEL DELIVERY

## Food parcel orders submitted to suppliers:

- **13,850** up to 4 July

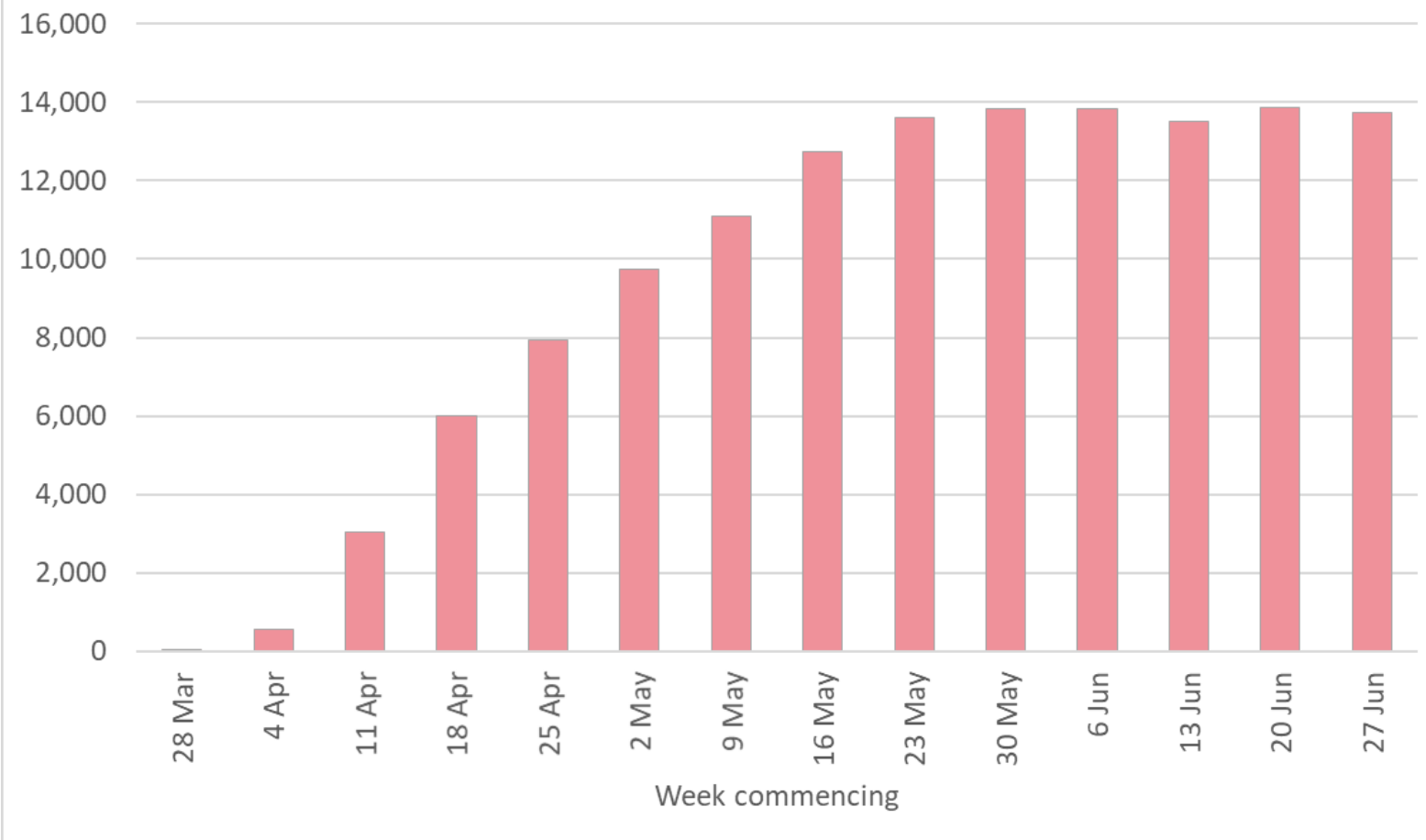
## Attempted deliveries:

- **133,450** up to 3 July
- **99%** handed to resident or left on doorstep
- **17,924** of which were successful first deliveries\*

\* higher than most recent orders submitted because some people asked for deliveries to stop after receiving one or more boxes

total weekly deliveries attempted



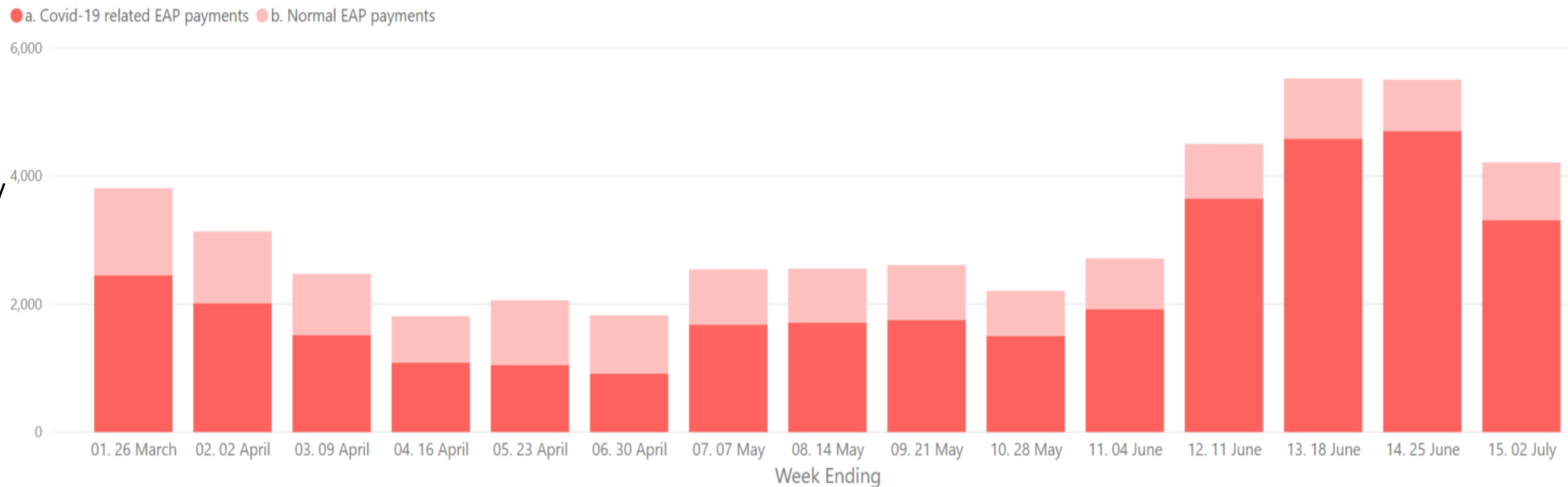
# DISCRETIONARY ASSISTANCE FUND (DAF)

Between 18 March and 2 July:

**33,642** COVID-19 related Emergency Assistance Payments, with a total paid value of **£2,083,730**

Recording started on 18 March. COVID-19 related reasons applicants are presenting include: Having to stop or reduce work; Delay to benefit claim; and Increased energy/food costs (family at home)

Following the 1 May announcement of increased funding, applications will be treated with greater discretion and flexibility when dealing with COVID-19 hardship claims.

# SUPPORT FOR BUSINESSES

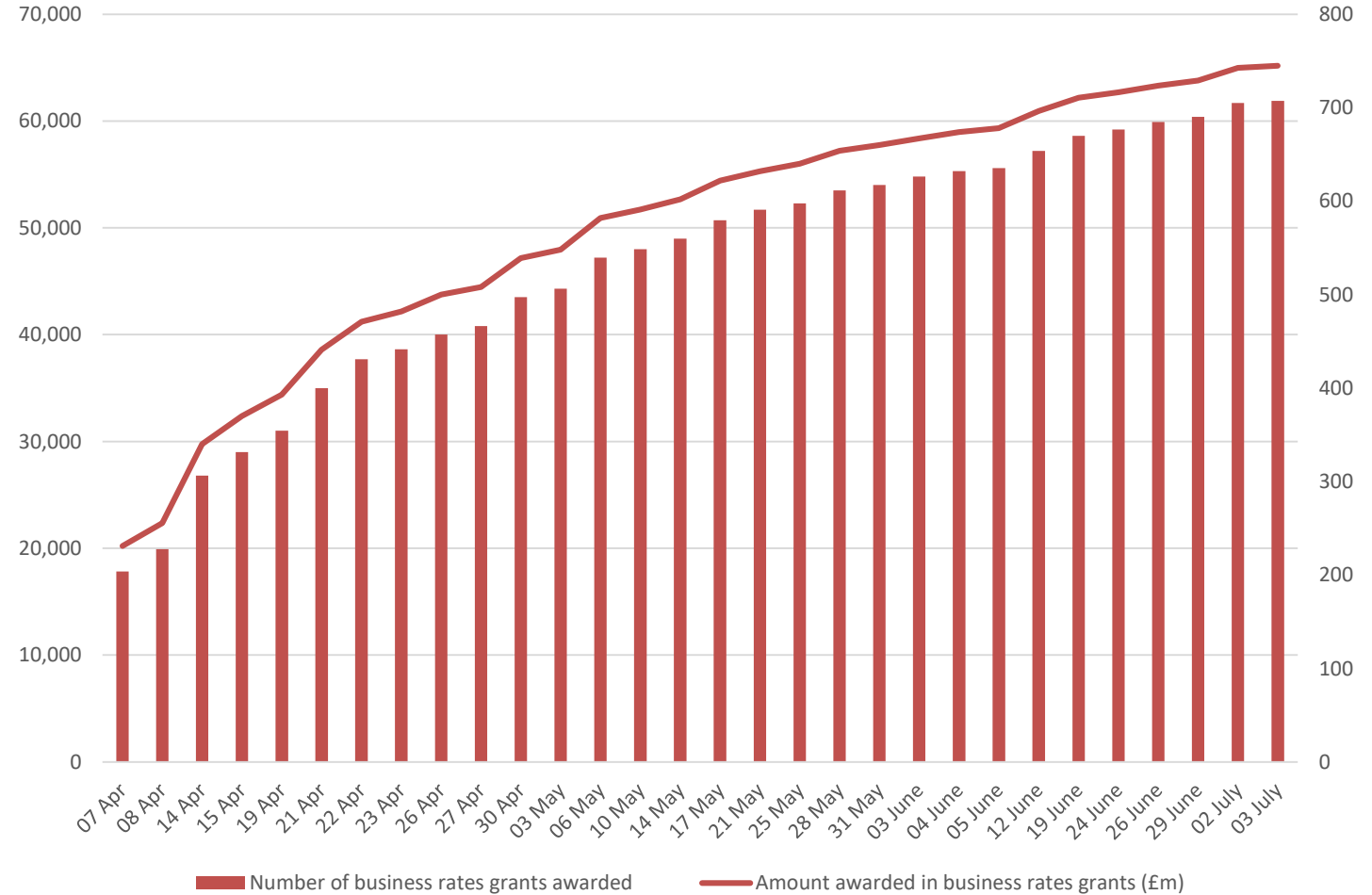
Local authorities have processed **61.9k** awards totalling **£744.8m** for the Covid-19 business rates grant.

The DBW's Covid-19 Wales Business Loan Scheme received **1,608** applications totalling **£103m**. As at 22 June, **1,390** businesses across Wales have been awarded funding totalling over **£94m** (£82.4m drawn).

The Economic Resilience Fund has received almost **6,900** micro-business applications totalling **£66.9m**, and almost **2,600** SME applications totalling **£142.8m**. The Larger Business Fund has received over **£26m** worth of applications, with further applications being processed which show the applications will likely increase to about **£28m**.

## **Third sector resilience fund**

Provides direct financial support for third sector organisations which need help to get through this crisis and by paying their bills and easing cash flow.

- **59 applications** have been approved, and **£2.42M paid** through the third sector resilience fund.

## **Voluntary services emergency fund**

Supports third sector organisations in the community who are coordinating the volunteer response seen across Wales, helping them to pay the out of pocket expenses of their volunteers.

- Over **110 applications** have been approved and **£5.17M paid** through the voluntary services emergency fund.
