

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# 1. Introduction

This report outlines the methodology used for a telephone survey of Communities for Work (CfW) and Communities for Work Plus (CfW+) leavers. The purpose of the survey was to provide data to support an evaluation of the impact of the European Social Fund (ESF) supported Communities for Work (CfW) and the Welsh Government (WG) funded Communities for Work Plus (CfW+) programmes.

CfW supports people who are economically inactive and long-term unemployed, focusing on two separate groups - those aged 25 and over; and those 16-24 year olds who are Not in Employment, Education or Training (NEET). CfW came into being on 1 May and the 2015-2018 phase of the programme was evaluated during this period. The CfW programme was extended to March 2023, with delivery taking place to June 2022.

CfW+ has been WG funded through the Children and Communities Grant (CCG) since April 2018 and the delivery model broadly mirrors the CfW programme in non-ESF eligible areas and to ESF ineligible participants within ESF areas. CfW+ supports people who are not eligible for CfW or other regional ESF provision and who are in or at risk of poverty due to a lack of employment. Despite the separate funding streams, CfW and CfW+ delivery teams work together as single combined teams.

The research involved telephone interviews with 236 individuals that had taken part in the CfW programme and 451 that had taken part in CfW+. All respondents had left CfW / CfW+ provision at least 12 months previously.

Fieldwork took place from 26 January to 17 February 2023. The majority of the calling took place on weekday evenings and at weekends.

# 2. Sampling

The sample of CfW+ participants was supplied to IFF by the Welsh Government. Files were provided for each individual Local Authority. These files did not follow a standard template and had similar but not identical variables. From these files a master file was compiled. This had 29,856 names of individuals. Of these, 25,201 had a telephone number, of which were 759 duplicate telephone numbers. Once deduplicated this left a file with 24,442 CfW+ participants with a unique telephone number. It should be noted that Blaenau Gwent had no telephone numbers, hence no participants from this local authority took part in the CfW+ part of the research.

The number of usable sample against what was originally received is broken down in Table 2.1.

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The sample for CfW came from sample initially supplied to IFF by the Welsh Government for the European Social Fund (ESF) participants survey which had not been loaded for that project. A total of 2,800 CfW participant names was loaded.

# 3. Questionnaire design

Tables 3.1 and 3.2 summarise coverage of the final agreed questionnaires, while the full English versions of the questionnaires are included in Annex A and B.

# 4. Fieldwork

Interviews were conducted by telephone using computer-aided telephone interviewing (CATI). Interviewing took place mostly on weekday evenings and on weekends, although some weekday daytime calling was undertaken if contacting people during these core times was unsuccessful.

The average interview length for the CfW survey was 13 minutes and 28 minutes for the CFW+ strand.

Quotas were set to try to ensure a balance between achieving a representative sample matching the population profile and trying to ensure minimum numbers of interviews in some categories for reliable analysis. For example, for CfW+ participants the number of interviews in Cardiff and in Rhondda Cynon Taff were each set at an upper limit of 45 interviews (10% of the achieved sample) to ensure other localities/regions were well represented (Cardiff and Rhondda Cynon Taff each represented 14% of the available starting sampling).

Tables 4.1 and 4.2 outline the quota targets that were set ahead of fieldwork as well as the numbers of interviews achieved in each quota.

It is worth noting that at the outset we had a target of achieving 40 interviews among those with a disability (9% of the overall target). In the initial CfW+ sample file 6% of records had a disability flag though 22% were blank on disability status. During early fieldwork it was evident that many more said they had a disability (a long-term illness, health problem or disability expected to last for more than one year) than this. As a result, the disability quota was removed, and of the 451 interviews 146 respondents said they had a disability (32% of the achieved sample).

It is worth noting that for CfW, 29 of the 236 interviews were with participants based in East Wales. This is equivalent to 12% of the total. Within the starting sample available for the survey 14% of CfW participants were based in East Wales. The quota target for East Wales (57) was set at 22% of the overall target number of interviews. It was set at this level, which was higher than the proportion in the East in the sample available at the start of fieldwork, to reflect the fact that in the overall sample file for the European Social Fund Participants Survey that IFF is conducting for the Welsh Government the regional split for CfW is 23% East compared with 77% in West Wales and the Valleys.

# 5. Response rates

In total, interviews were conducted with 236 CfW and 451 CfW+ participants. Call outcomes are shown in the following table. It should be noted that there was a target of 450 CfW+ interviews, and when this was reached interviewing stopped, hence the high figure for sample still live at the end of fieldwork.

A significant proportion of records were unusable because the telephone number supplied was incorrect (19% of the sample loaded for CfW and 13% of CfW+). For 4% of CfW and 5% of CfW+ sample, the named respondent did not recall doing the provision, while a small proportion said they were still on their course or under 16, making them ineligible for the survey. Table 5.2 shows adjusted response rates, excluding this unusable sample.

# 6. The profile of respondents

This section looks at the starting sample of CfW and CfW+ participants and compares this to the achieved profile. Weighting was applied to the CfW findings (discussed in the next section) hence we show the unweighted and weighted profile.

# 7. Weighting

The CfW dataset was weighted to ensure it was representative of the population of CfW participants. This was done by region, gender, and employment status, as follows:

No weighting was applied to the CfW+ data as the achieved profile was very close to that of the population (based on the database of available sample, as shown in Table 6.2).
