Indicator data	StatsWales data tables; indicator data for LSOAs and a range of aggregations. Open Document Spreadsheets; indicator data published at the LSOA, Local Authority and Constituency Area Levels.
Indicator data split by age	StatsWales data tables for income and employment deprivation, and repeat absenteeism, by age
LSOA domain maps	Maps showing deprivation in LSOAs across Wales. This includes maps showing the counts of people in different age groups living in income deprivation in LSOAs across Wales.

Deprivation analysis relating to children	Summary analysis of selected indicators relevant to children.
Welsh Index of Multiple Deprivation 2019: analysis relating to areas of deep-rooted deprivation	Further analysis relating to areas in deep-rooted deprivation using WIMD 2019 indicator data.
General practice population	Updated (Apr 2023) StatsWales data tables for deprivation at GP practice and cluster levels.
Analysis of population characteristics by area deprivation (Census 2021)	This analysis uses WIMD 2019 and Census 2021 data to estimate the proportions of population groups living in areas within each WIMD 2019 deprivation grouping.

LSOA look-up	Open document spreadsheet: Match LSOA to different geography groups including Primary Care Clusters
Postcode to geography lookup	Open document spreadsheet: Look-up to match a postcode to its corresponding LSOA, local authority etc.
Postcode to WIMD rank lookup	Open document spreadsheet: Look-up to input lists of Welsh postcodes and identify the LSOAs that they fall into and their associated WIMD 2019 rank, decile, quintile and quartile.

GP and primary care cluster article	This article and dataset provide options for analysing the relative deprivation of the population registered to each general practice and primary care cluster in Wales.
