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National Survey for Wales: cognitive testing of the April 2024 to March 2025 questions Executive Summary

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1. Introduction and methodology

- 1.1.1 Background
- 1.1.2 The National Survey for Wales is a continuous survey involving up to 12,000 randomly selected respondents aged 16 and over across Wales each year. The survey covers a wide range of topics including public services, employment, childcare, the Welsh language, and health and social care services. Topics are reviewed each year to ensure the survey continues to meet the needs of survey users.
- 1.1.3 As a result of the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, the National Survey has gone through considerable changes since 2020, moving from face-to-face to telephone during this period. Since 2022-23, the survey has also included a follow-up self-completion online section. From 2024-25, the option was added for an interviewer-led face-to-face survey (CAPI), including a self-completion section on a tablet (CASI).
- 1.1.4 The aim of this research project was to cognitively test a range of new questions developed for the National Survey for 2024-25. Cognitive testing explores how participants understand, process, and respond to individual survey questions, with the 2024-25 cognitive work covering a mix of pre-existing and new questions that had not been tested before. It is important to test survey questions to ensure that respondents understand question concepts or tasks in the way the researchers intend, that they understand them in a consistent manner, and are willing and able to provide answers. This helps to ensure that the survey results are reliable, valid and unbiased.
- 1.1.5 Methodology – desk review
- 1.1.6 Prior to cognitive testing, a thorough review of the proposed new questions was carried out using Kantar Public's Questionnaire Appraisal Framework (QAF). This has been adapted from [QAS-99](#) to focus more clearly on issues that impact on social research questionnaires. It provides a systematic framework for evaluating questions, enabling the user to identify and correct potential problems with questions that may lead to difficulties in question administration, miscommunication or other failings. The user examines questions by considering specific criteria (such as clarity, assumptions, instructions, knowledge/recall, task difficulty, sensitivity and

social desirability bias) and decides whether the question exhibits features that are likely to cause problems.

1.1.7 Findings from the review were provided to WG, comprising comments on each question along with recommendations for any changes to wording for the first round of cognitive testing. The findings from this review also fed into the development of cognitive testing probes, to ensure that key issues were tested in sufficient depth.

1.1.8 Methodology – cognitive testing

1.1.9 A total of 22 in-person interviews were conducted over two rounds by three Kantar Public researchers, with respondents with a range of different characteristics. Kantar Public interviewed 11 men and 11 women of various ages and educational qualifications. Roughly half the interviews at each round were conducted in Cardiff and the other half in Wrexham.

1.1.10 The first round of testing aimed to identify any problems with the questions by exploring the respondents' understanding of the questions and response options. The second round tested changes made to questions which were found to be problematic in the first round, while also re-testing a number of questions which were unchanged from Round 1 (to gather additional evidence on answer strategies and provide further reassurance that they are working as expected). In addition, several new questions were added (as a result of Round 1 findings) in the following sections:

- Sport Wales – Encouraging participation
- Sport Wales – Volunteering and coaching
- Natural Resources Wales – Flood risk
- Natural Resources Wales – Green and natural spaces
- Natural Resources Wales – Environmental concerns and action
- Awareness of local councillors

1.1.11 The sample was recruited by Kantar Public's partner agency [Criteria Fieldwork](#), a specialist qualitative recruitment agency. Recruiters specialising in finding

respondents among the general public used various methods to recruit people for the quotas specified. These included: 'snowballing' from respondents who had previously undertaken research via the agency and/ or partner agencies, networks within their established communities and visiting local areas to establish new contacts and networks.

1.1.12 Table 1.1 outlines the question topics that were covered at each stage. Questions in the 'Sports Wales – Spectating' section were not carried forward to Round 1 as they were deemed sufficiently straightforward as to not require testing. The questions on 'Awareness of community and town councillors' and 'Confidence in Justice System' were also not taken forward to Round 1. A number of issues were identified with these questions at the desk review stage, and the topic deemed too complex to cover appropriately in the survey at this stage.

2. Round one testing

- 1.1.13 Overall, the majority of the questions evaluated in round one worked well, with respondents understanding the questions without issue and easily providing an answer. As such, the majority of questions were unchanged moving into the second round of testing. For example, the questions on Encouraging Sports Participation, Environmental Action, and Noise Hazards worked well and very few changes were suggested.
- 1.1.14 However, some questions (and in some cases whole modules) were identified as being a cause of concern. The Sport Wales question around local facilities proved problematic due to inconsistencies of interpretation – some respondents thought about the number of facilities available, while others thought about the range of activities on offer. A separate problem arose where respondents answered in relation to general use of these facilities, rather than focussing solely on their own use. There were also issues with the questions on Biodiversity. Respondents tended to think only about their own local area (as opposed to Wales as a whole, as directed in the question text) and some struggled to differentiate between their level of concern about decreasing biodiversity and a more basic acknowledgment that it is happening.
- 1.1.15 Changes and improvements were recommended to a number of questions based on the findings for these questions. A range of revisions were applied based on feedback from the first round of testing, e.g. the wording of some questions and response options were changed slightly; and interviewer instructions and examples were added or changed where respondents were unsure about how to answer.

3. Round two testing

- 1.1.16 The second round of testing allowed for the revised questions to be evaluated to determine if the proposed changes had helped to lower the cognitive burden for respondents, and allowed for the remaining questions to be tested by a wider pool of participants.
- 1.1.17 Most of the revised questions were well understood by the respondents, with the clarifications and changes applied after the first round of testing seen to help participants' overall understanding.

1.1.18 However, some problems were still identified:

- Sport Wales Encouraging future participation – the question asking about things that might help respondents take part in more sports or physical activities (SportMore) did not work well. The prompted response list resulted in several respondents selecting answers that didn't really apply to them.
- Sport Wales Facilities – The changes made following Round 1 did not address the issues identified. Respondents who hadn't used local facilities still offered a view (either agreeing or disagreeing) based on other factors, such as observations (e.g. facilities they've noticed while driving), information from local media, or speculation based on what they think other people might want or need.
- Natural Resources Wales Biodiversity - These questions presented a significant cognitive challenge for respondents, relying on them having some knowledge and understanding of the subject matter, which most respondents didn't have.
- Natural Resources Wales Green and natural spaces - Interpretation of questions on the quality of local green spaces varied. It was clear that some respondents didn't understand what they were being asked.

1.1.19 Annex A summarises the questions that were tested in each round. The initial table for each topic (in blue) highlights the iterative process that each survey question went through from the original wording evaluated during the desk review, and during the first and second round of cognitive testing. In some cases the wording was unchanged, i.e. the wording used in the desk review mirrors the final proposed wording, but in others the wording changed during one or more stages of the cognitive testing process.

1.1.20 The second table (in red) shows the final version of the questions proposed to Welsh Government.
